On its way to the Pacific Ocean, the Navarro River meanders by the rich plantings of Filigreen Farms. Carefully tended heritage apples and rambling berry patches thrive alongside sturdy Pinot Noir vines. With round and rolling flavors of red cherry and opulent blackberry, Filigreen Pinot Noir culminates in a smooth and lingering toasted vanilla finish.

This wine expresses the ego of place ... the unique expression of a carefully nurtured piece of land, made manifest in each bottle. To this end, we do without conventional pesticides and synthetic fertilizers. We treat the soil and all we grow on it as a living, life-giving system.
