High in the Mayacams Mountain Range, red tail hawks circle above the secluded Rocky Top vineyard. The rugged terrain, graveled red soils and full wind exposure are particularly well-suited for Mediterranean grape varieties.

Combined with dry-farming techniques, the vines produce moderate crops of full and balanced flavors. Supported by a backbone of firm, lingering tannins, Rocky Top is accentuated with rich black fruits and ripe berries.

As Biodynamic farmers, our intention is to treat the soil and all we grow on it as a living, life giving system. From natural composts, colorful cover crops and lively insectary areas to our owl boxes, mobile chicken coops, pasture animals and family garden, our farming practices create special wines, and sustain the land for generations to come.
