- California Certified Organic Farmers
- Certifies organic farms
- Initial 3 year certification period, followed by an annual inspection of vineyards and winery to remain certified



WINES MADE WITH ORGANICALLY GROWN GRAPES

- CCOF certified fruit: No synthetic pesticides, herbicides, fungicides or weed sprays
- Made at a certified organic winery
- Sulfites may be used at bottling (Up to 100ppm allowed, dried fruit has a sulfite concentration of 400ppm)

SAUVIGNON BLANC, Mendocino County

Distinctive tangy kiwi fruit, bright citrus zest, and lemon grass.

CHARDONNAY, Mendocino County

Refreshing pear, crisp apple, and citrus with creamy vanilla spice.

PINOT NOIR, Mendocino County

A harmonious blend of flavors: wild berries, luscious cherries, and the spicy vanilla of toasted oak.

ZINFANDEL Mendocino County

Rich, jammy berry, plum, and distinctive white pepper spice.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Mendocino County

Ripe and plummy, with intriguing notes of anise and brown spice.
