Nestled between rugged coastal mountains and ancient redwood forest, Mendocino's benchland vineyards produce Chardonnay grapes with round, ripe flavors of pear and apple. At the headwaters of the great Russian river and north of Napa Valley, Mendocino County is considered by many the last wine frontier. An area know for its simple way of life and breath-taking natural beauty, the grapes grown here seem to take on a bit of the free-spiritedness of the locals themselves.

This food-friendly, well-balance Chardonnay is the perfect complement for wood-grilled salmon, roasted chicken and butternut squash risotto, shrimp scampi, or zucchini fettuccine Alfredo with a hint of lemon.
