At the headwaters of the Russian River, Mendocino County is considered one of California's pristine and less traveled wine regions. An area known for its simple way of life and breathtaking natural beauty, the grapes grown here express the care that results from generations of family farmers.

Sketchbook Pinot Noir is bright and juicy, with leather and earth on the nose and flavors of Bing cherry, crunchy red fruits, and a delicate, lingering finish.

Pairs well with many Bravo dishes, including: Pasta Fra Diavolo, Pasta BRAVO!, and the Grilled Salmon.

Vineyards: 100% Mendocino County

Cooperage: Aged 12 months in a combination of new and seasoned American oak barrels, redwood tanks and stainless steel
